If possible, we are asking if the year 6 children can stay that day until 4:30pm to ensure that there are enough people to run the stalls and tidy away at the end.

Parents wishing to collect children from years 3-5 from 2:30pm to visit the fayre together, will need to go to classroom doors via the playground where they can sign children out. Please be aware that children will only be allowed to leave with named adults from the collection arrangements form unless the school office is notified beforehand. Children not being collected from these year groups will be released at the end of the school day as normal.

We would be delighted to see as many of you that can attend. Brothers, sisters, aunties, uncles and grandparents are also welcome. It will take place on the school playground unless there is adverse weather when the event will be held in the hall.
