Dear parents and carers,

As the clubs for the Autumn term finish today I wanted to take this opportunity to share with you the range of opportunities that your children have engaged with since September.

Some amazing facts:

- 595 before and after school club places available to children each week since the start of the Autumn term
- 228 children have taken up places at the clubs
- 152 children have chosen to attend 2 or more clubs each week
- 528 club places are provided without a charge to parents
- 67 club places are provided by selected external providers who we enjoy a close working relationship with and are able to provide opportunities that would not otherwise be available in school
- 164 club places were available for music, art, culture, learning, health and wellbeing and garden
- 431 club places for sporting opportunities

Since half term the number of club places has been swelled further with Miss Harrison and Mrs Wintle working with 70 children across years 4 – 6 as she prepares us for our Christmas production. This took the number of club places each week in the second half of the autumn term well above 600.

In addition to this, we have a daily strategy games session at lunchtimes, Fun Club on a Thursday lunchtime and our Young Farmers who work alongside a staff team in the farm each day.

I am incredibly proud of the opportunities that are available to our children. I work with the most amazing staff team who give up so much of their own time to share their passions and expertise with our children. I would like to say a huge thank you to Mr Robinson, Mrs Chessell, Miss Furlong, Mrs Bottomley, Mr Miles, Miss Lewis, Mr Price, Mr Timms, Miss Gray, Mrs Salter-Vaile, Mr Darby, Miss Thorn, Mrs Brydon, Miss Cull, Miss Harrison, Mrs Wintle, Miss Jenner and Miss Vousden. I would also like to thank Mr Croft who continues to share his passion for rugby with us every Thursday evening.
