



Dear Parents and Carers,

Exciting news!

We have recently signed up to the Hampshire School Library Service Ebooks, and children are now able to borrow **eBooks and Audiobooks** from our exciting new eBook library, found here:

The library catalogue is full of bestselling, popular fiction titles and will offer your children a 24/7 library, in addition to our well stocked print library in school when we return. Students can have 2 books out on loan at any one time, and they will automatically return after 2 weeks, or children can return them early in order to loan a new book.

The books are age rated, which means your children can only read books that are age appropriate. There are also settings that can be customised to enable children who suffer with reading difficulties to enjoy reading without specialised equipment or books – we will be working with those children to setup their preferences.

The eBooks can be read on a computer, laptop, or through the free App on your tablets or smartphones.

You will need to log on using your username and password:

Username: first three letters of your first name and first three letters of your surname

Password: mrjs

For example Mr Bessant's log in details would be

username: davbes password: mrjs

Reading through your web browser on a laptop or computer

To access the eBook library, students need to login using their pre-assigned username and password, through the link listed above. Children can browse the collection or search for a specific book title, author or publisher and loan the book they choose. It is then assigned to them for the 2-week period.

Reading through the App

To download the App, search "eplatform" in the App store and download. You will then need to enter the username and password assigned and, as above, search for a book to read. Using the App, the books will be temporarily downloaded to the device so children will not need internet connections once the book has been loaned to read, great for travelling abroad!
