Dear Parents and Carers

This term the children in year 3 have a fantastic opportunity to learn about the local harbour and environment linking to our science curriculum. Children will gain invaluable knowledge about the harbour including map reading, wildlife including plants, dangers, hazards and safety.

The sessions will be led and run by Chichester harbour school who have a depth of knowledge and experience to provide high quality sessions that the children will enjoy and remember.

Therefore, please come to school wearing the following on your dates:

- **A change of clothes. Long t-shirts and trousers (preferable not jeans) The footpath is a little over grown so long trousers instead of shorts or dresses would be better.**
- **Old trainers/shoes or wellies**
- **If it's likely to be wet weather, waterproof coats will be needed.**
- **If it's likely to be hot and sunny, sunhats will be needed.**

Hygiene measures will be followed for these sessions with all children and staff thoroughly washing their hands before and after each session. Social distancing measures will be in place for these sessions. Staff from Chichester Harbour School and any additional staff required for the trip will keep a 2 meter distance from the children at all times. For any indoor activities, additional staff will be required to wear a face covering. The class bubbles, teacher and teaching assistants will remain the same therefore children will not need to social distance from their consistent adults but should avoid physical contact and time spent face to face.

There is no charge for this trip and lunch time will happen as usual on these days.
