Gardening Club Update

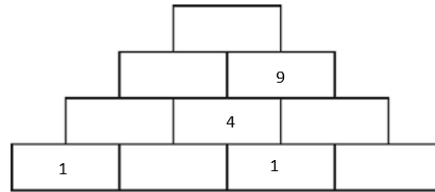
On Thursday, The Hayling Horticultural Society and some of our

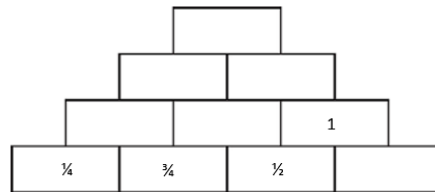
Maths Challenge
