Homework

In Year Six, it is really important that children complete their homework each week as the homework tasks given are essential skills and make a big difference to pupils' learning in class. They are also good preparation for when the children move into secondary school.

Summer Term Curriculum Map

English Wonders of Nature

Summer 1

To start this term, we will be writing an explanation text about the defense mechanisms of a creature of our choice. Then we will write a first-person narrative based on a film text, 'The Alchemist's Letter'.

Summer 2

In this half term, we will be looking at poetry and will looking at and building on different skills used to create poetry such as rhyming and figurative language.

Computing

3D modelling

In this unit, we will be developing knowledge and understanding of using a computer to produce 3D models.

Sensing movement

We will be revisiting programming this half term and using the micro:bit to help us practice different coding constructs before we will be designing and creating our own micro:bit step counter.

Music

This term we will be looking at the composition of music and playing the glockenspiels. We will also be looking at the history of black music and looking at how music style has influenced and changed over the years. We will also be identifying some key figures within black music.

Maths

Summer 1

We will be finishing the year 6 curriculum with lots of practice before SATs.

Summer 2

We will be putting our problem-solving skills to the test by planning our own Enterprise event, including budgeting and profit margins.

Spanish All about me

In this unit, we will be learning how to describe our family, our hobbies, our personalities and our appearance.

Art Summer 2 Pop Art

In this unit, we will be learning about the Pop Art movement and will use complementary colours to create pieces of art in the style of Andy Warhol and Roy Lichtenstein.

Geography Mexico
