Homework

In Year Four it is really important to continue to embed good homework habits. Therefore, we are asking that you take a little and often approach. The tasks given build on essential skills and make a big difference to learning in class. We would really appreciate your support in helping to embed key skills and strategies that have been taught in lessons.

Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS) – children complete 20 garage sessions each week online, using either a computer or tablet. **This resets on a Friday morning.** All children are issued with their TTRS login and password. Please keep this safe.

Spellings – these are handed out every Friday and **tested the following Friday.**

Reading – please read with your child every day if possible, but at least 5 times a week, for around 10-20 minutes. Please can you sign journals each week and hand them in.

Arithmetic - your child will bring home a weekly Arithmetic test which should help them practice key maths skills. The children should spend no more than 25 minutes on this activity.

SPaG – children will use www.spag.com to complete a series of spelling, grammar and punctuation questions either using a computer or tablet. All children are issued with their login details. Please keep this safe. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to ask us.

Summer Term 1 Curriculum Map

English : Narrative

During this unit we will explore how narratives are written and then apply what we find to try to write our own alternative chapter for 'Electrigril'



Poetry

We will explore the layout of the poems in the text 'The Magic Box', by Kit Wright, before writing and performing our own poems.

Maths

This half term we will continue to apply our knowledge of place value to solve calculations in statistics.

Science : Sound

The children will learn how sound is made, know what pitch and volume mean and know what happens to sound as you move away from the source.

Art: Drawing

In Art we will be developing our drawing skills. We will learn to use tone, shading and texture and will explore Zentangles.

Spanish: Weather

Linguistic skills: Weather
Cultural: Famous matador – Manolete and festival running of the bulls in Pamplona.

Music: Ukulele

This term the children will learn to play the ukulele and be able to identify the different parts of the instrument.

Religious Education: Authority

We will be looking at what authority means and who has authority over us. We will explore what authority means to followers of Judaism.

Summer Term 2 Curriculum Map

English : Persuasion

We will use the information from 'Toro Toro' to write a persuasive letter to request a ban on bullfighting.



Narrative

During this unit we will use 'Toro Toro' to write our own scene description.

Maths

This half term we will be exploring shapes in geometry, interpreting graphs in statistics and measures in different contexts.

Geography: Spain

We will explore where Spain is within Europe, we will learn some of the human and physical features of Spain and learn about some of the cultural features of the country.

Religious Education: rituals

The children will explore rituals within their lives, before exploring Hinduism and Christianity the rituals that are upheld.

DT : Cooking and Nutrition – Spanish wraps

The children will revise the different food groups and what makes a healthy diet. They will then investigate Spanish ingredients and then design and make a Spanish themed wrap

Science: Animals and Humans

The children will learn about digestion and the function of teeth. They will also discover what a food chain is, and what a predator and prey are.
