Reminder about school uniform

School Uniform:

- White polo shirt
- Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan
- Dark grey trousers, skirt, culottes or shorts (not black)
- In the warmer months pupils may wear a blue and white checked dress
- Black school shoes or plain black flat, ankle boots which are appropriate for school
- White, grey or black socks, or black, blue or grey tights

PE Kit:

- Plain or shadow stripe navy shorts
 - PE t shirt – plain white or navy blue
 - Trainer
 - Plain or navy-blue tracksuit
 - Plain PE hoodie – navy blue
- Make-up, false eyelashes, nail varnish or jewellery – must not be worn for school.

Hair – Shoulder length and longer should be tied back with a discrete hair band. Oversized bows and other accessories should not be worn. Hair should be of natural colour.
